

€8,700 PER PUPIL PER YEAR

Tuition fees are €8,700 per student per year. This price includes intensive French language instruction in accordance with the French National Education programme, as well as general education in English covering several subjects (English, maths, geography, art, music). Classes are small (6 to 10 students) to ensure personalised attention.

Also included:

- Supervised homework at school,
- Comprehensive school insurance,
- Spanish lessons (2 hours per week),
- Mandarin Chinese lessons (1 hour per week),
- Promotion of reading,
- Faith awareness through music,
- Financial education from Year 9 onwards,

GIS UNIFORM: A POWERFUL SYMBOL OF OUR IDENTITY AND VALUES

The GIS uniform reflects simplicity, equity, and cohesion. It helps to prevent judgement based on clothing differences, avoids superficial comparisons, and reinforces mutual respect—core values of our educational ethos.

Uniforms may be ordered directly through the school, or purchased independently by parents, provided that the prescribed colours and styles are strictly adhered to.

REGISTRATION FEE - €300 (€150 FOR RE-ENROLMENT)

This fee secures the pupil's place and ensures optimal integration. It covers all administrative procedures and individual follow-up, and is non-refundable in the event of withdrawal. The reduced fee for re-enrolment reflects the continued trust of families.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES - €220 PER PUPIL (Including books and textbooks)

Supplies are carefully selected by our teaching team for their quality and durability, and are standardised for all pupils to ensure equity and consistency. This centralised system prevents frequent omissions, allows for rapid replacement during the school year, and guarantees immediate access to required materials. It greatly simplifies family organisation while supporting a cost-effective and environmentally responsible approach.

MEAL AND LUNCH BREAK SUPERVISION - €350 PER PUPIL (annual fee)

Lunchboxes prepared by families are served at the table in a calm environment. The protocol includes handwashing before and after meals, tooth brushing, and a high-quality recreational break.

A daily, exclusive 30-minute "brain gym" session is also provided—a genuine cognitive booster that enhances concentration and memory, preparing pupils for effective afternoon learning.

FLE - FRENCH AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE (30 hours/year) - €450 (if applicable)

This programme is aimed at non-French-speaking (or partially French-speaking) pupils. The aim is to enable them to make rapid progress in both oral and written French, to better understand instructions, and to fully integrate into classroom life. Sessions are held in small groups, supervised by specialist teachers.

ENHANCED ENGLISH PROGRAMME FOR NON-BILINGUAL PUPILS (FROM YEAR 5) - €450 (if applicable)

This programme is open to all new students from Year 5 onwards and offers 30 hours of intensive English lessons per year:

- Small group lessons led by specialised teachers
- Rapid progress in both oral and written expression and comprehension
- An ideal complement to the FLE programme for non-French-speaking pupils

PREPARATION AND PRESENTATION FOR CAMBRIDGE EXAMINATIONS (FROM YEAR 5 TO YEAR 11) - €150 PER PUPIL

Preparation for Cambridge examinations is an integral part of our English-language curriculum. From Year 4 onwards, all pupils benefit from dedicated lessons organised in small groups according to their level, with personalised support.

Lessons include practical exercises, mock examinations, and comprehensive guidance to ensure each pupil's success.
